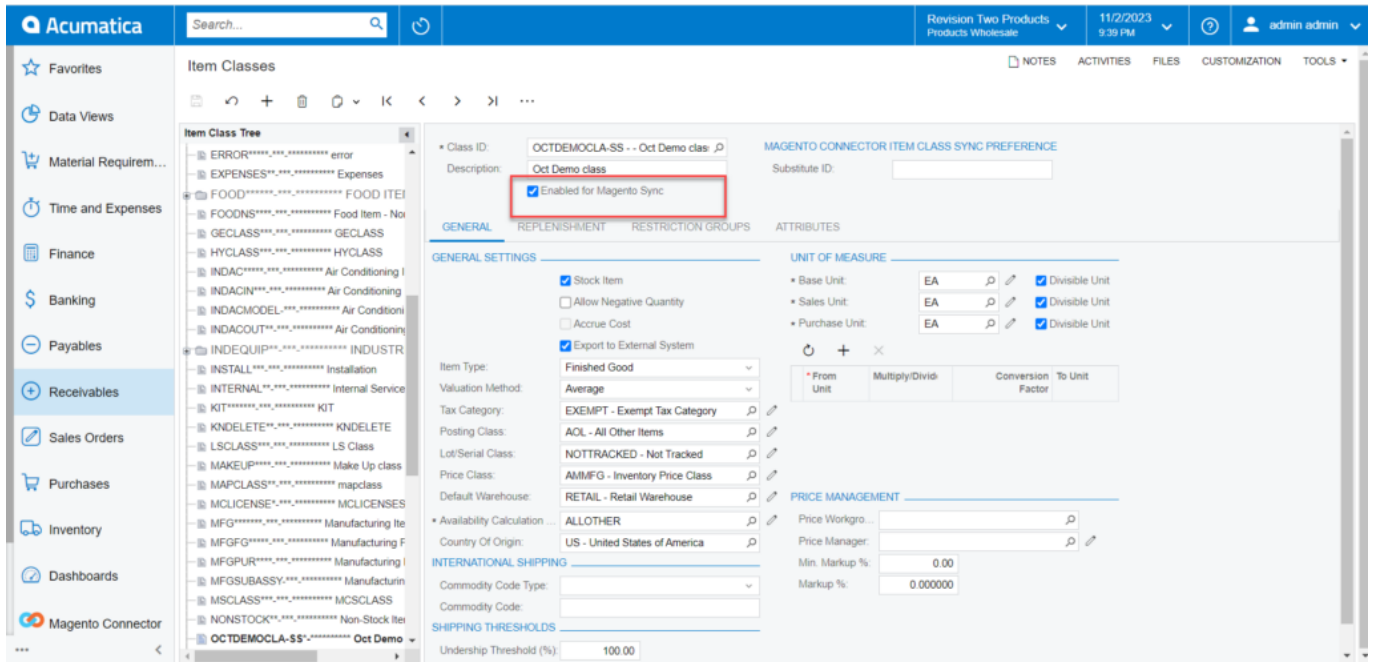



Creating Item Class in Acumatica

The checkbox for **[Enable for Magento Sync]** should be checked. This option comes from the **[Inventory Preferences]** within Acumatica.

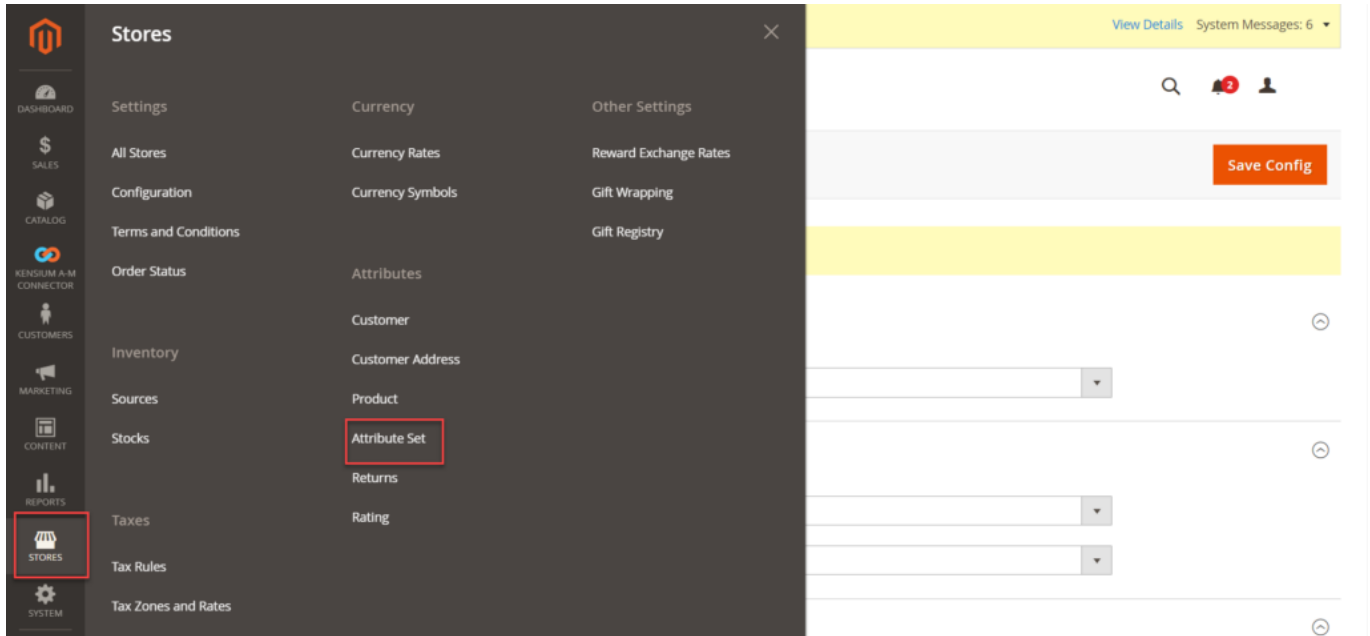

Ecommerce Settings in Inventory Preferences

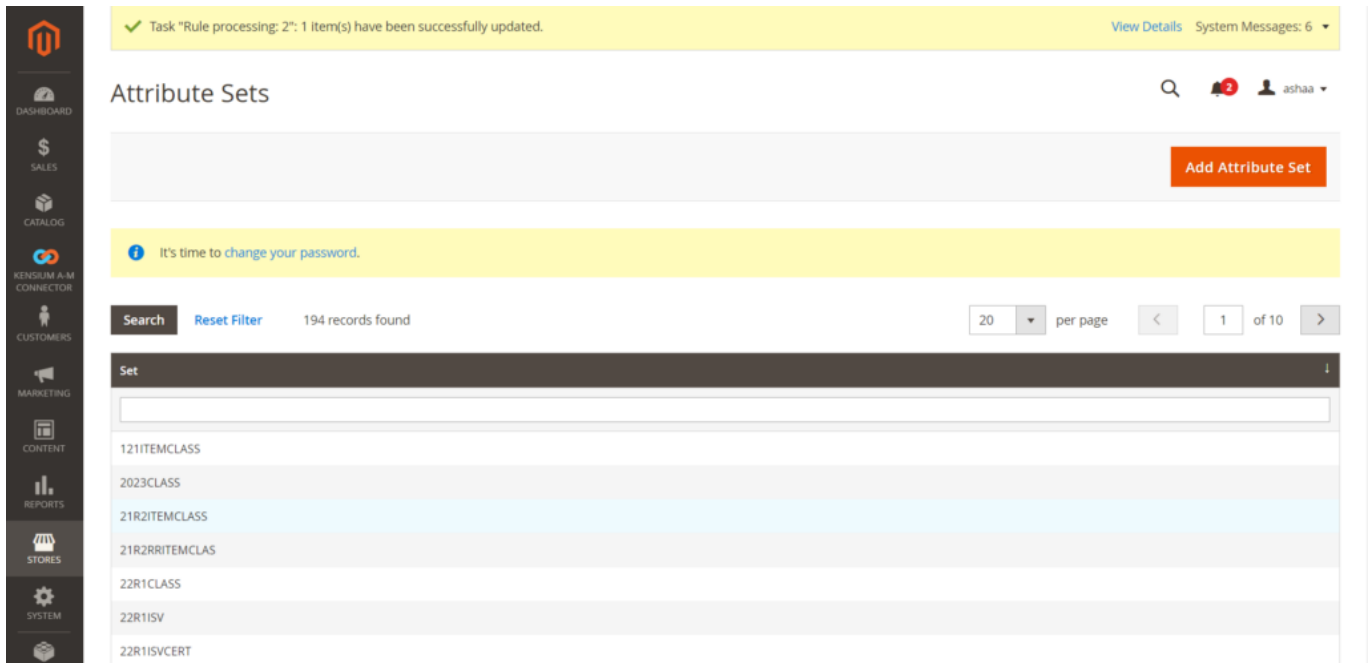

In Magento, it will automatically sync. Go to Magento and click on the [Store] on the left panel and under Attributes you will find an option [Attribute Set].




Attribute Set in Stores
