



Managing Payment Configuration in Settings

 This section allows you to enable the Payment Gateway. The application supports PayPal, Authorize.Net, Braintree and Apple Pay. For B2B you need to set up the Payment Configuration. Upon clicking on the Payment Configuration, you will be redirected to the following screen. These Payment methods are applicable for Invoice Payments only.



Note that, Payment methods for orders still respect the BigCommerce Payment Method Configuration.


1. Paypal: To enable Paypal you need to check the option for **[Enable Paypal Payment Gateway]**.

 - c. Enter the Sort Order.

 - d. Sort order: Select the sort order.



 - d. Sort order: Select the sort order.
