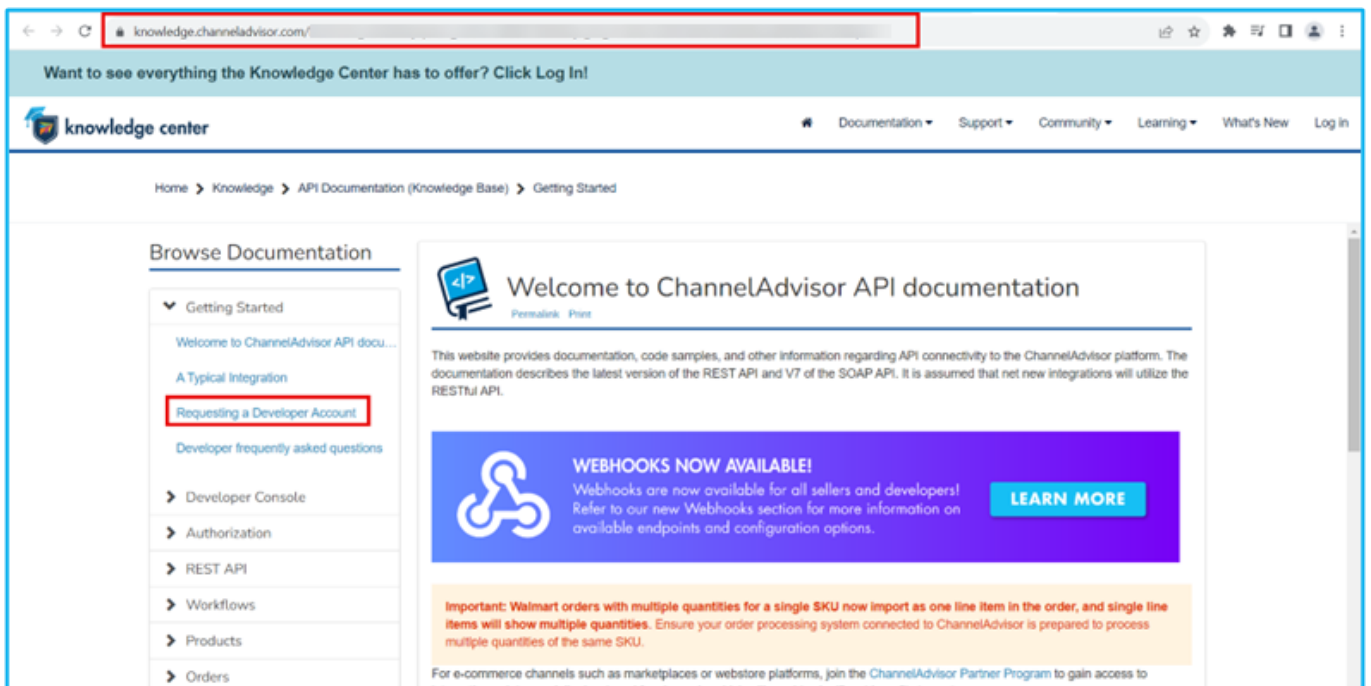

A developer account is required to make requests using either ChannelAdvisor API.

Developer password reset

Important: SOAP requests include the developer key and password. Changing the developer password will cause any SOAP requests to fail until the SOAP requests are updated to use the new password. Reach out to your ChannelAdvisor contact or contact Support to request a password reset ([Contact Us](#)).

Go to the [Developer Console](#), and click the **Reset Password** link, where you will be directed to enter the Developer Key for the reset. An email will be sent to the email address affiliated with the Developer Key, initiating the reset process. For other questions, contact your ChannelAdvisor contact or Support ([Contact Us](#)).
