New Features and Enhancements

Renamed the Endpoint to FRFusionAdvanced in Web Service

We have updated HandHeld to use the renamed endpoint in the web service, changing it from FRFusionWMS to FRFusion Advanced.

Navigation: Integration → Web Service Endpoints under Preferences, the following screen will appear.

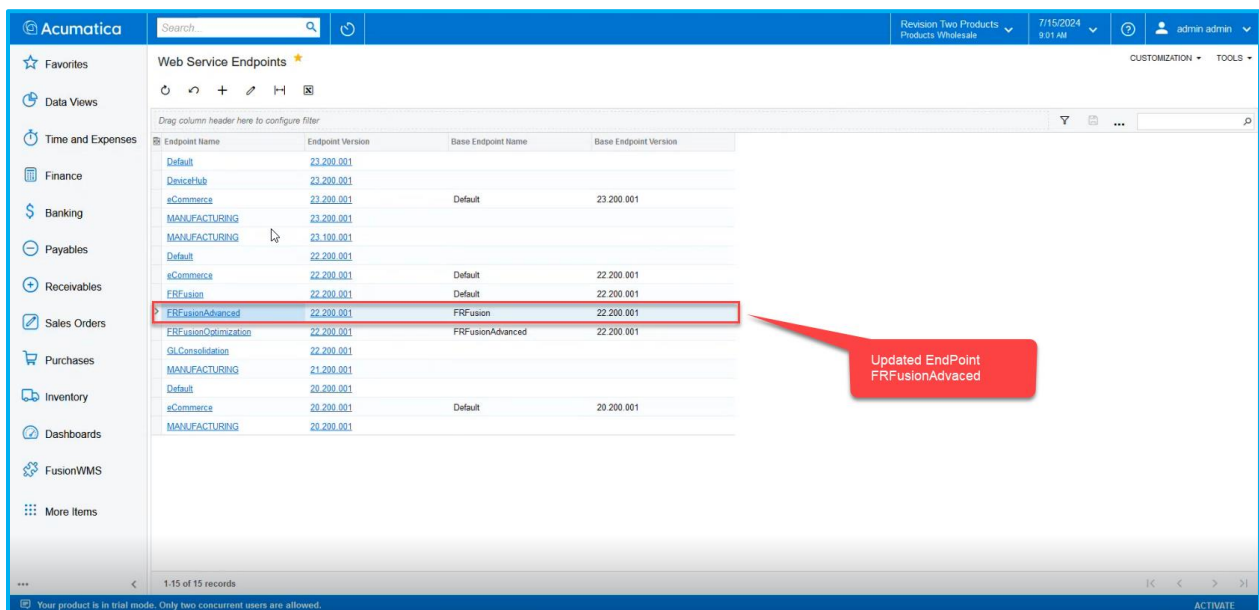


Figure: The updated endpoint FRFusionAdvanced

Introduction of Primary Location on the HandHeld

We have added an option on the HandHeld as [Primary Location] in the [Put Away] module. When you assign any Primary Location in the Item Warehouse Details, the same will be reflected on the new field on the HandHeld.

Navigation; Inventory → Item WareHouse Details → Primary Location

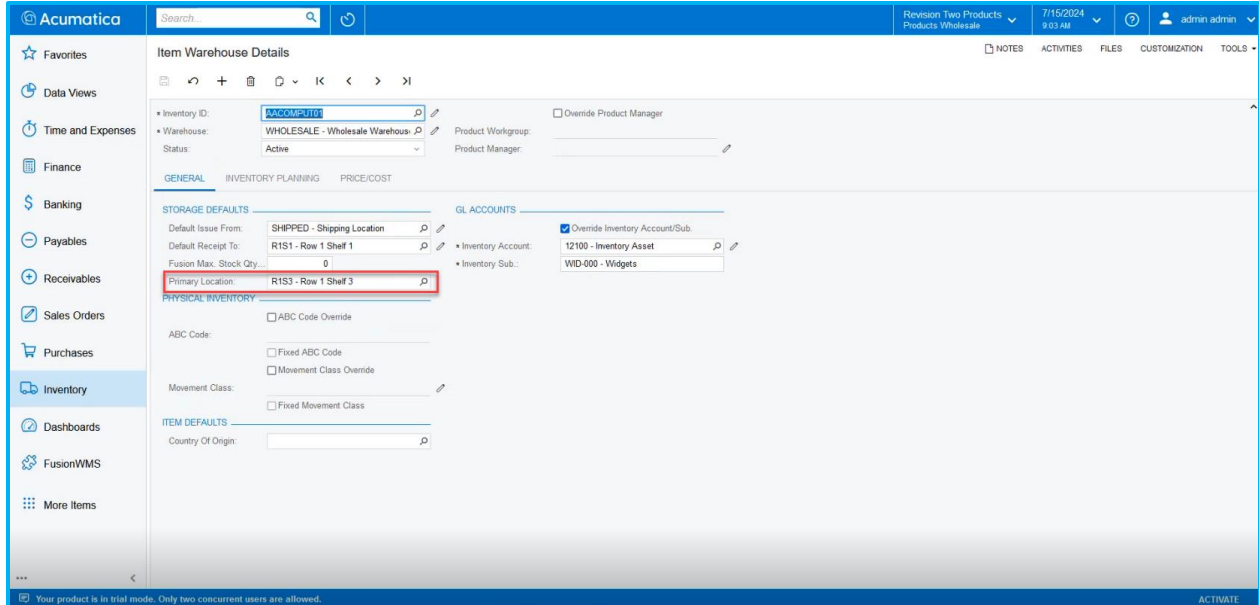


Figure: Primary Location on the Item WareHouse Screen

Navigate to HandHeld and click on the [PutAway]. Prim Loc field will be displayed on the Putaway screen.

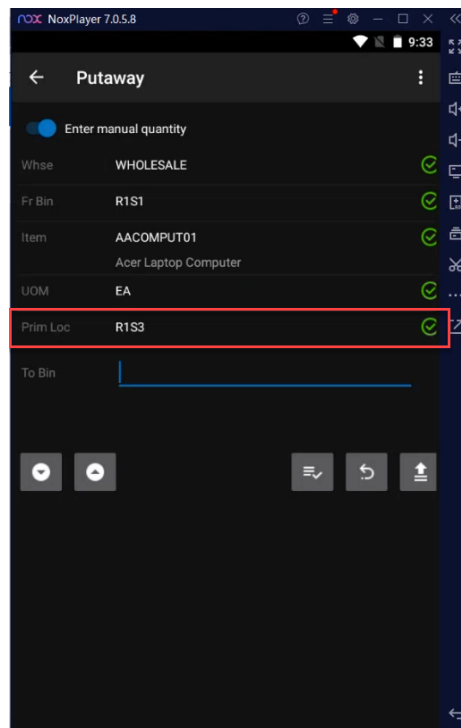


Figure: Prim Loc field on the Putaway screen

Sales Order Number field on the HandHeld

On the Handheld, there are three options for packing a shipment: Pack screen, PickPack, and Multipack. When you create multiple SO line items with different S.O. numbers and ship them using the Pack, PickPack, or Multipack screen, the Handheld will display the respective Sales Order Number.

Navigation Sales Order → Create Sales Order

Illustration:

- Create a Sales Order with relevant details and [Save] it.

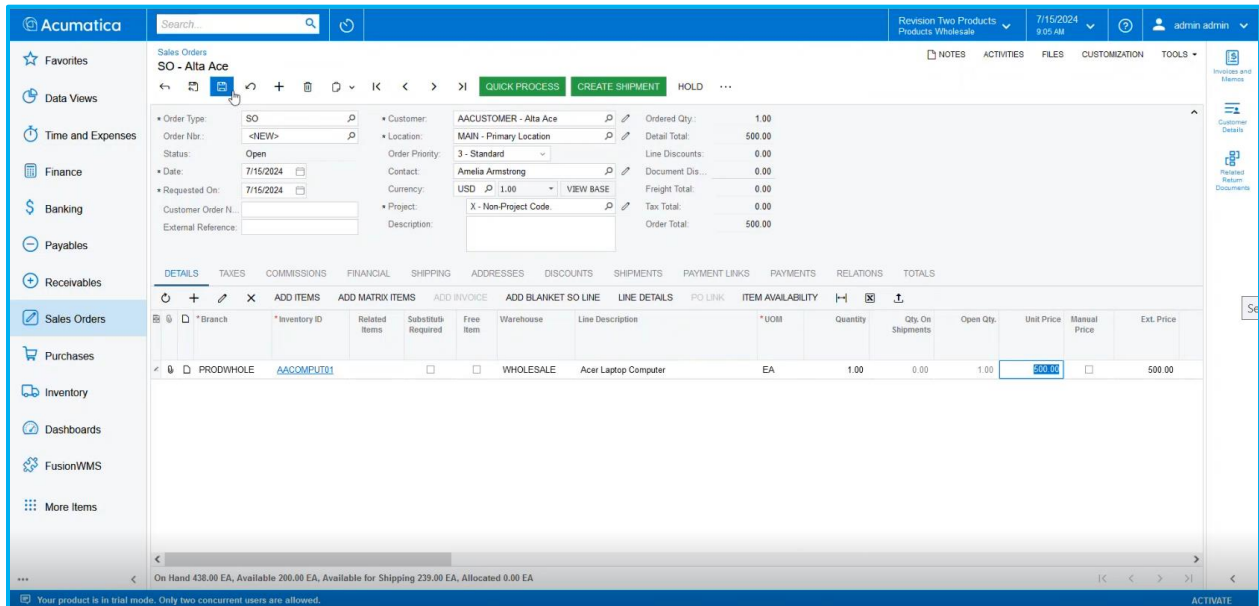


Figure: Sales Order

- For multiple sales orders, create another Sales Order and [Save] it.

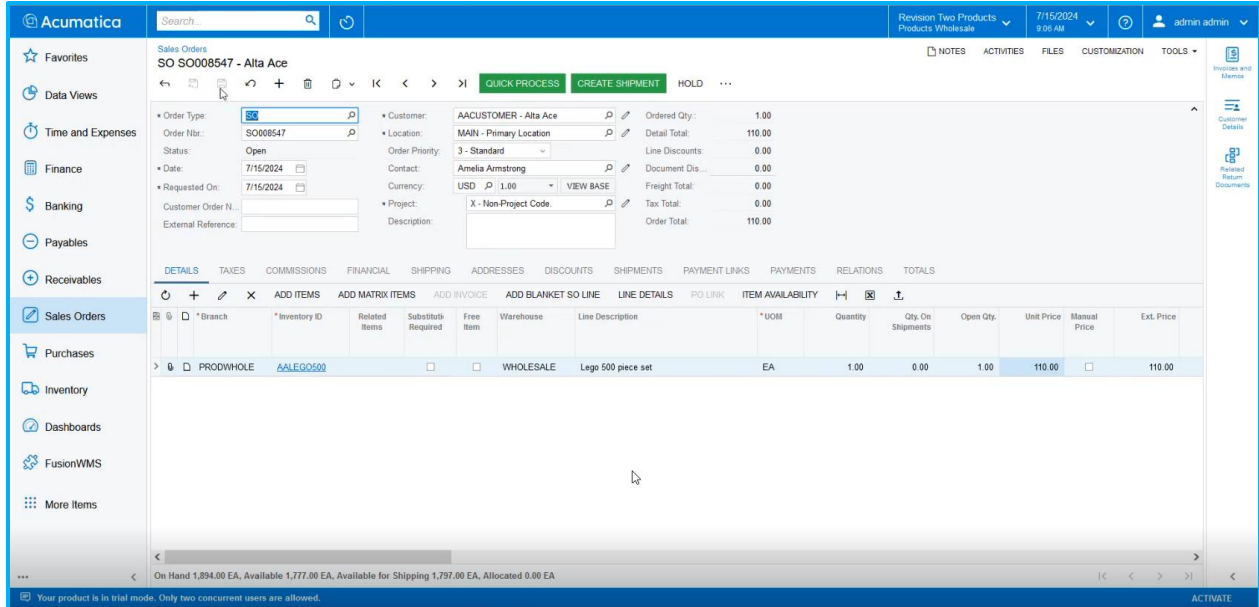


Figure: Another Sales Order

- Now create the shipment for the sales order by using the [Create Shipment] functionality.
- Add the Sales Order to the Shipment. On the Shipment Screen, multiple sales orders will be recorded.

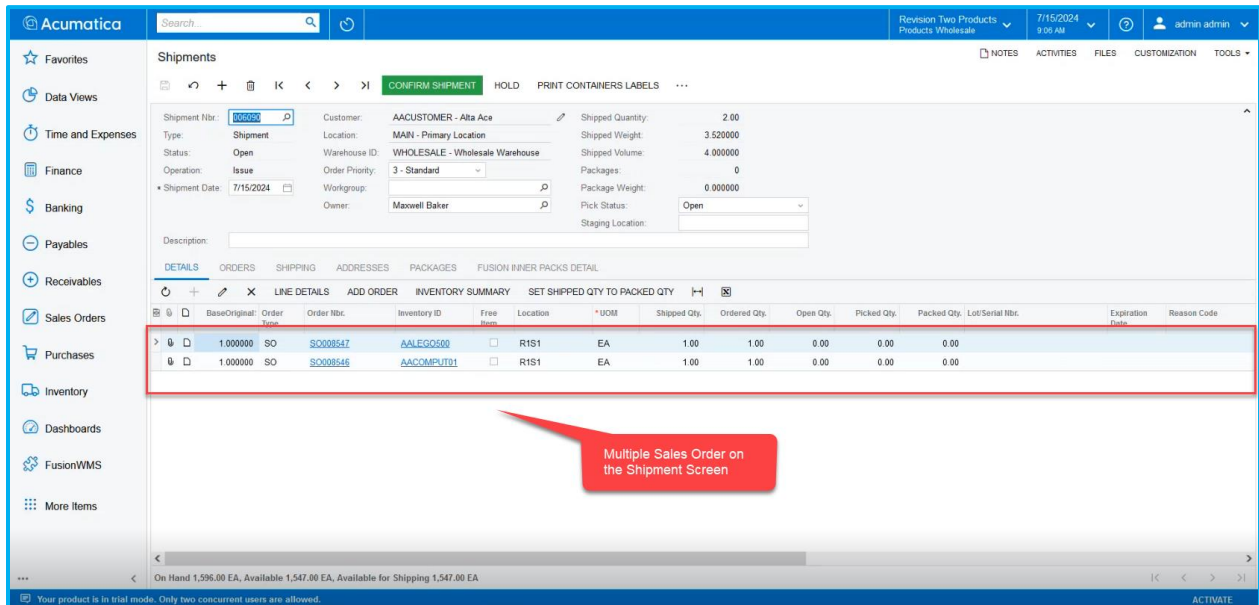


Figure: Multiple Sales Orders in the Shipment Screen

- **Navigate to the Handheld and click on PICKPACK.**

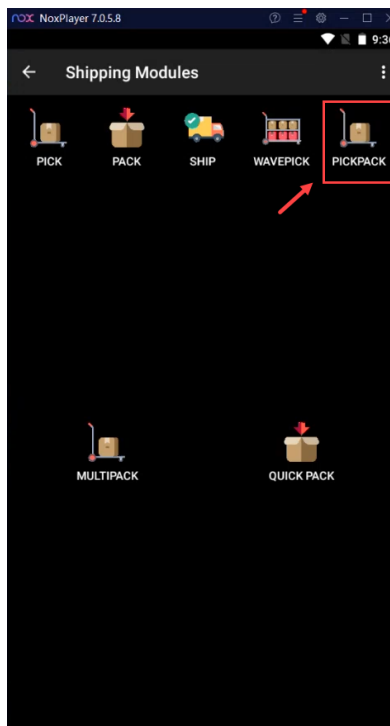


Figure: Click on PICKPACK

 You can navigate to the PICKPACK/ PACK/ MULTIPACK screen.

- **Copy the shipment number and enter it into the Pick & Pack screen.**

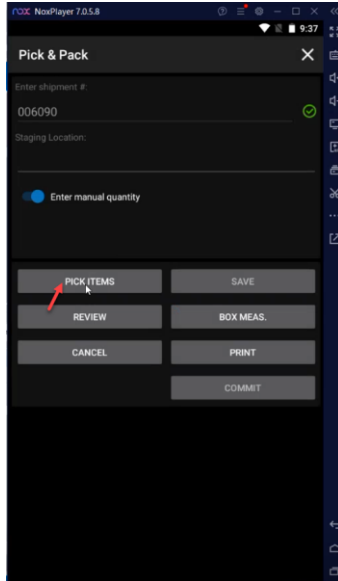


Figure: Click on the Pick Items

- **Click on the Pick Items. The associated SO number is displayed in the HandHeld.**

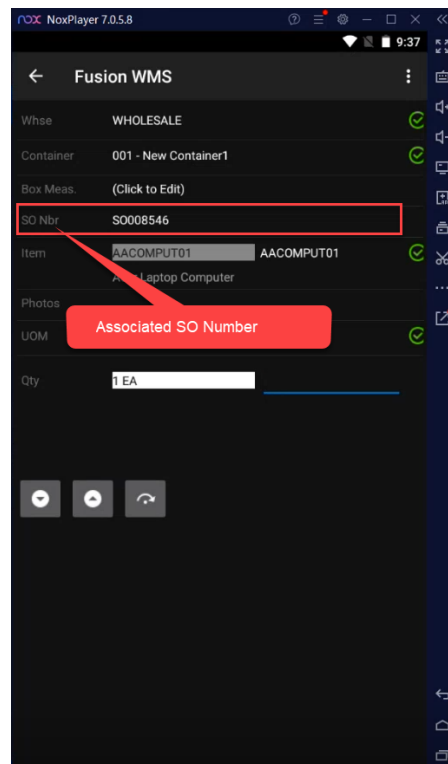


Figure: So Number field introduced

The SO Number field has been introduced on the HandHeld.

Pick Status changed to Picking from Assigned

We have replaced the Pick Status Assigned to Picked when you select any shipment record by using HandHeld the Pick Status will be changed to [Picking].

Illustration:

- Create a Sales Order and [Save] it.

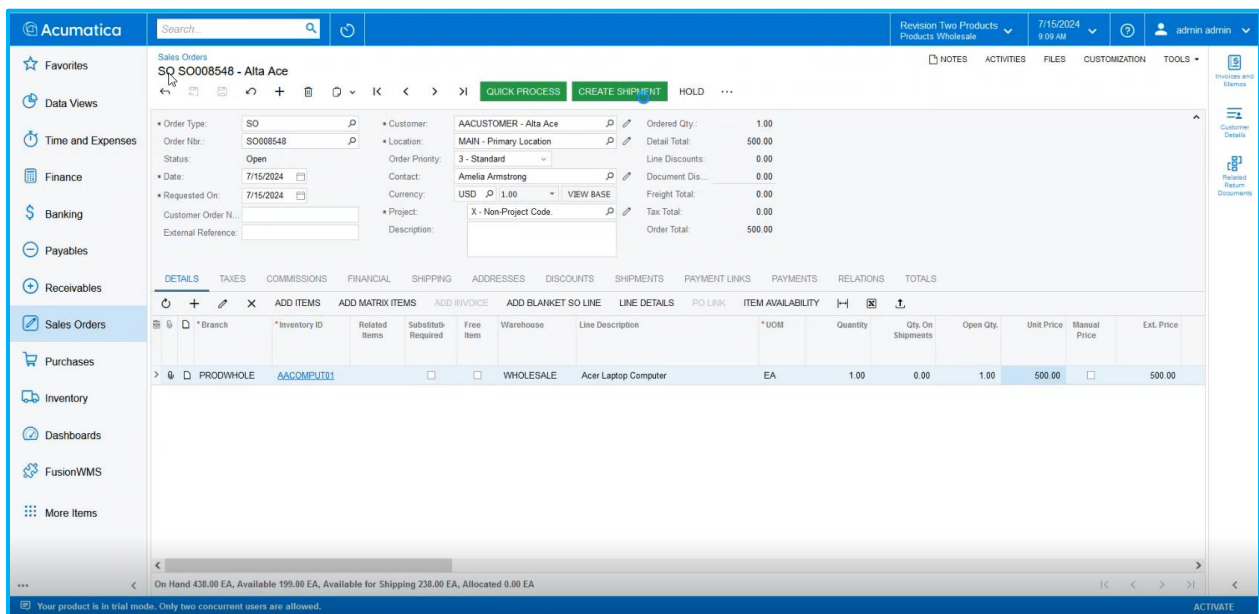


Figure: Create a Sales Order

- Create Shipment by using the [Create Shipment] button. The Pick Status should remain as [Open].

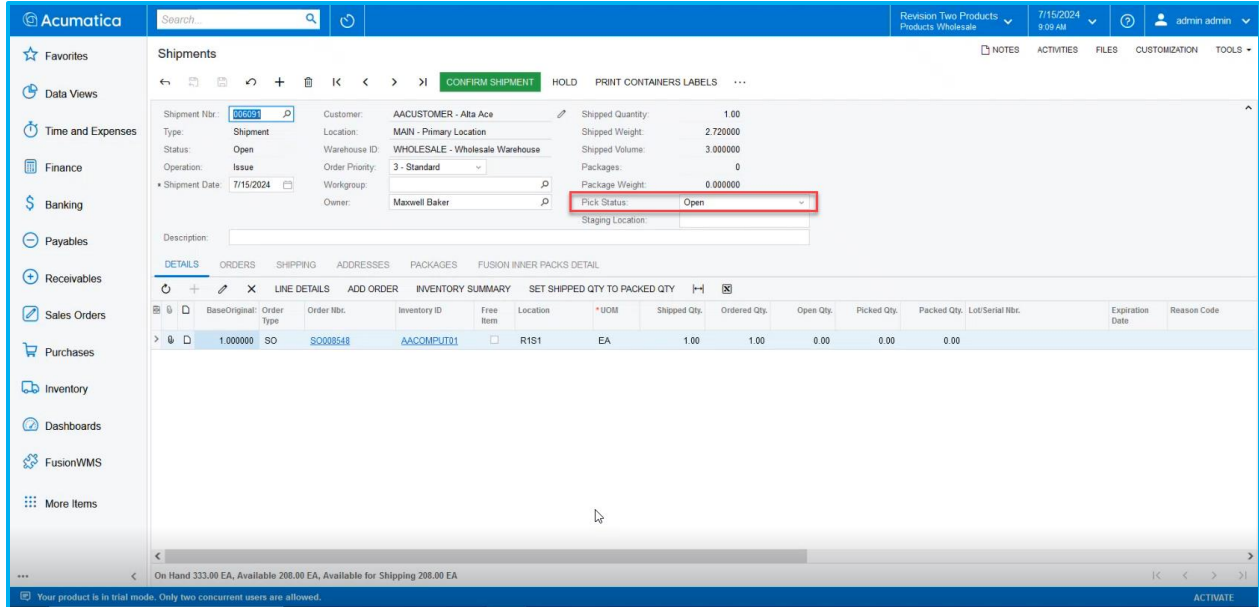


Figure: Pick Status remains as [Open]

- **Navigate to the HandHeld to enter the shipment number from the [Pick] option and refresh the Shipment screen the Pick Status will change to [Picking].**

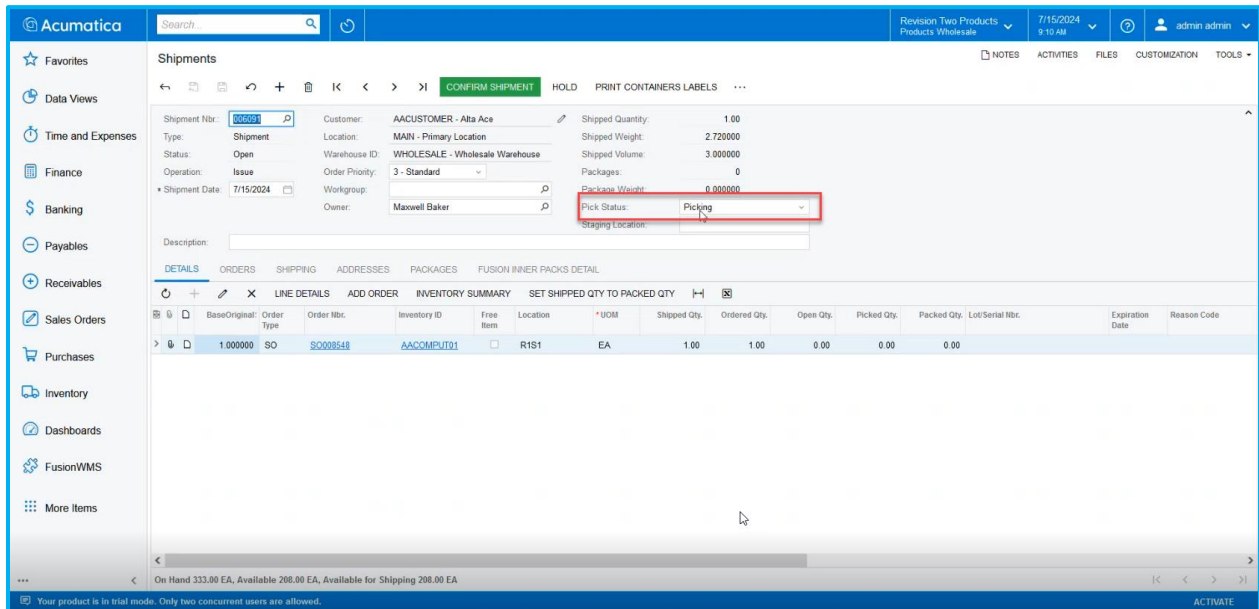


Figure: Pick Status will be changed to Picking instead of Assigned

Pick Status changed to Committed from Packed

After completing the Pack process by using Pack Screen, Multi Pack or PickPack through HandHeld, on Acumatica, the Pick Status will be displayed as **[Committed]** instead of Packed.

Illustration:

- Create a Sales Order and [Save] it.

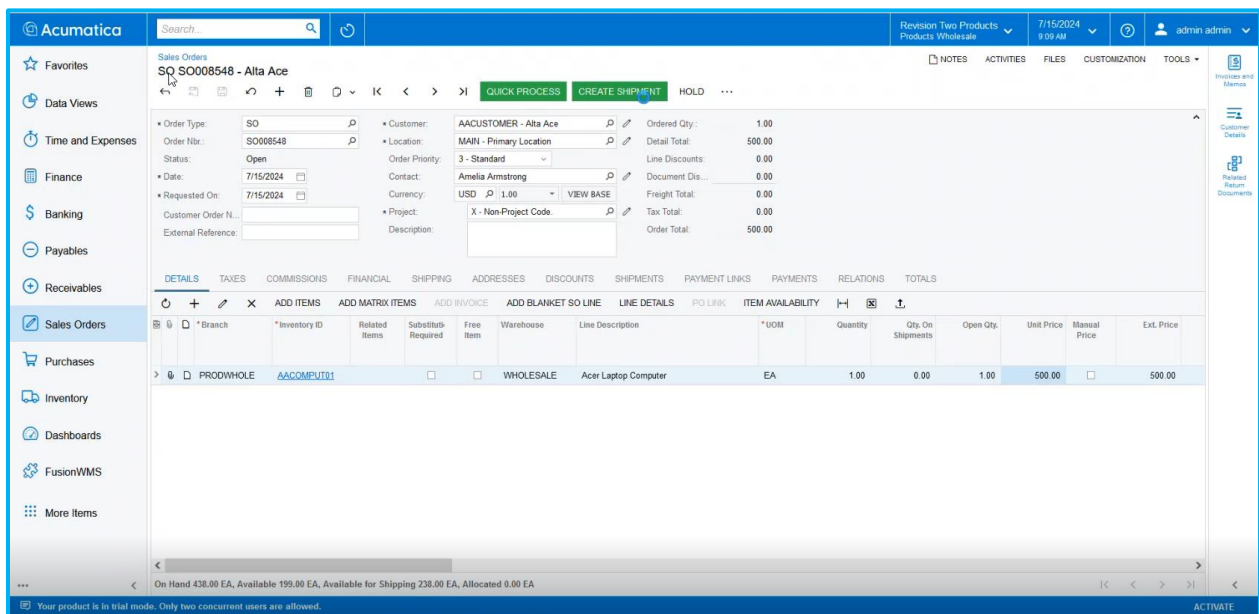


Figure: Create a Sales Order

- **Navigate to the HandHeld to enter the shipment number from the [Pick] option and click on the Commit button on the HandHeld.**
- **Navigate to the Shipment module on the HandHeld complete the [Pack] process and [Save] it.**

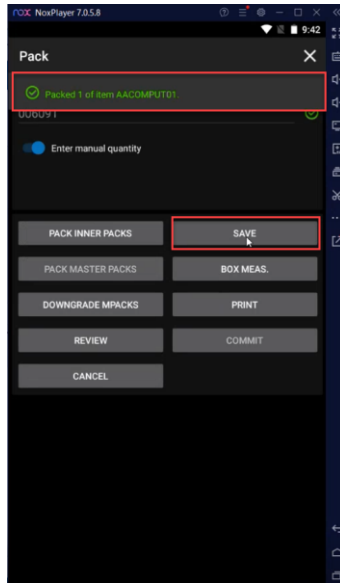


Figure Item Packed

- **Navigate to the Acumatica Shipment Screen and refresh the screen. The Pick Status will be changed to [Committed].**

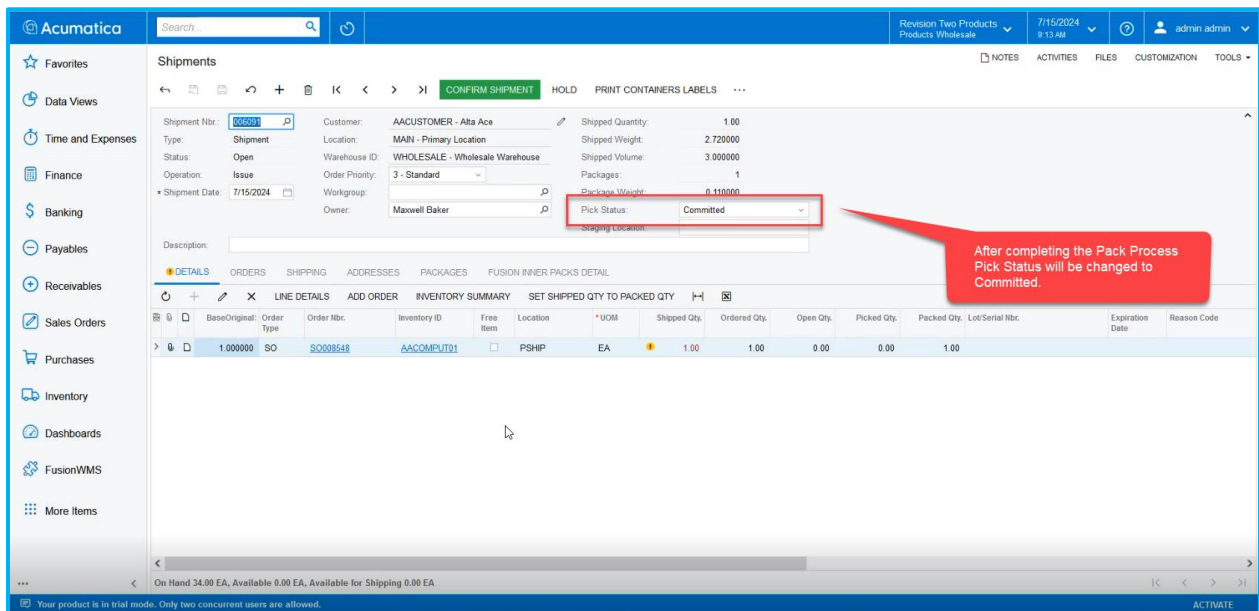


Figure: Pick Status displayed as Committed

Fields introduced under the Cross References in Stock Item

We have added the following fields under the Cross References tab in the Stock Items.

- Length
- Height
- Width

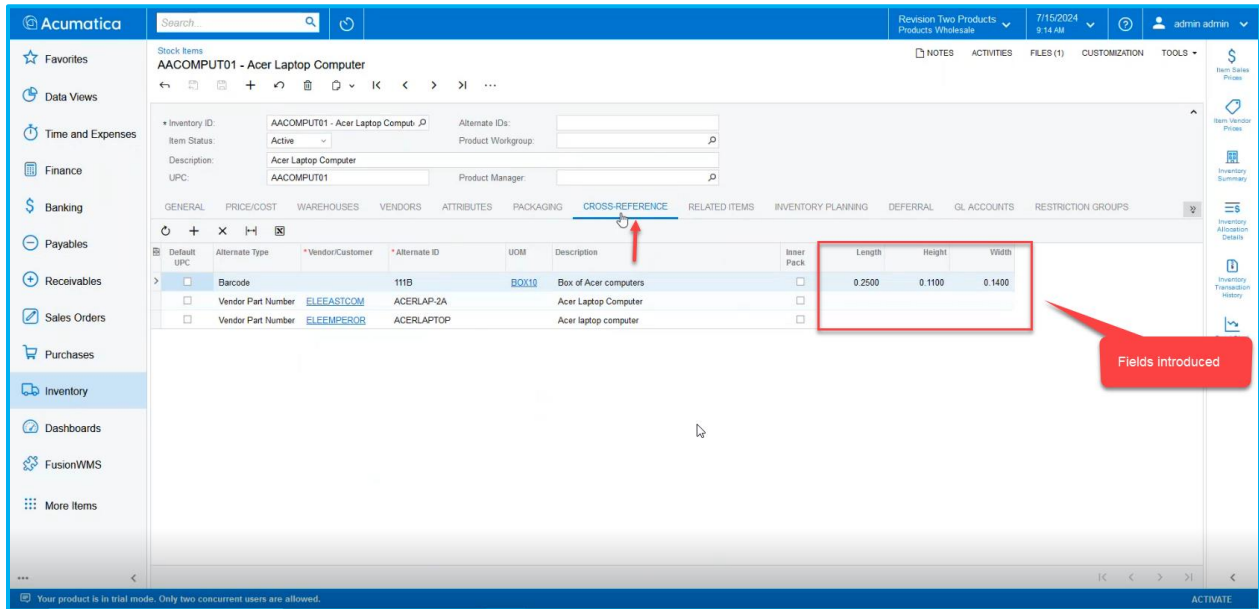


Figure: New Fields under Cross References

Known Bugs and Issues Fixes

- In the [Process Order] screen we have resolved an issue. An error message appeared after clicking on the [Optimize Shipment] when the action type was selected as [Create Shipment].
- In the [Process Order] screen upon clicking on the Optimize Shipment the grid color was displayed on the first page. The color indicates the stock quantity. If the stock item has enough quantity for shipment the grid becomes green otherwise red. Instead of showing all the pages it was showing only one page.
